



CODE OF CONDUCT SIGNED ACCEPTANCE

SACAC Sports programs play an important role in promoting the physical, social and emotional development of children.

It is therefore essential for parents, coaches, players and volunteers to embrace the values of good sportsmanship. Moreover, adults involved in SACAC Sports events should be models of good sportsmanship and should lead by example by demonstrating fairness, respect and self-control.

I therefore pledge to be responsible for my words and actions while attending, coaching, officiating or participating in a SACAC Sports event and shall conform my behavior to the following code of conduct.

- I will not engage in or encourage my child to engage in unsportsmanlike conduct with any parent, coach, player, official or any other attendee.
- I will not force my child to participate in SACAC Sports.
- I will not engage in or encourage my child to engage in any behavior which would endanger the health, safety or well-being of any parent, coach, player, official or any other attendee.
- I will not use drugs or alcohol or encourage my child to use drugs or alcohol while at a SACAC Sports event and will not attend, coach, officiate or participate in a SACAC Sports event while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- I will not engage in or encourage my child to engage in the use of profanity.
- I will treat and encourage my child to treat any parent, coach, player, official, or any other attendee with respect and tolerance for others that are of different **Ethnic, Cultural and/or Religious Backgrounds.**
- I will not engage or encourage my child to engage in verbal, physical or visual threats or abuse aimed at any parent, coach, player, official, or any other attendee regardless of **Race, Creed, Color, National Origin, Gender, Sexual Orientation, Religion or Ability**
- I will not initiate or encourage my child to initiate a fight or scuffle with any parent, coach, player, official, or attendee.



I hereby agree that if I fail to conform my conduct to the foregoing while attending, coaching, officiating, or participating in a SACAC Sports event I will be subject to disciplinary action, including but not limited to the following in any order or combination:

- Verbal Warning issued by the league or SACAC director will be given to the offending participant.
- Written Warning issued by the league or SACAC director to be signed by the offending participant in addition to a one game/match suspension.
- Expulsion of the current Season and the offending participant will be given a written notice issued by the league or SACAC director. The offending participant will be allowed to compete in future Seasons under probationary standing
- Permanent Ban of all SACAC Sports issued by SACAC director.
- Appeals may be received by the offending participant and guardians ONLY after a permanent ban has been put in place. The appeal will be submitted to the Executive Committee of the SACAC Board via the appropriate athletic director or the General Manager. The appeal must be in writing and received no later than 15 days after the Permanent Ban has been delivered. Appeals are NOT allowed for verbal warnings, written warnings or expulsions.
